**Rules of Competition**

USGA rules are in effect as well as our Local Rules.  
Be mindful of pace of play and play ready golf.

**Keeping an up-to-date Handicap**

You MUST enter all scores whether you played 9 or 18 holes as per USGA rules whether you are playing for fun or competing.

Your handicap is determined by posting scores for all rounds of golf (home or away). If you have played 9 to 13 holes, post a nine hole score. If you have played 14 or more, post an 18 hole score. When playing fewer than 18 holes, but more than 14, the holes not completed shall be scored as par plus handicap strokes you are entitled to receive on those specific holes to create an 18 hole score.

If a player picks up or wishes to take his or her max score, NET DOUBLE BOGEY is applied which limits the number of strokes a player can post on a hole depending on the player's handicap once a handicap is established. The max per hole is double bogey plus any handicap strokes the player would have received on that particular hole.
